You may still use other REAL ID approved Government ID such as your passport, a passport card, Global Entry Card, TWIC, Telos, etc. The reason we are reminding people is that travel insurance will not issue a refund if a customer books a flight tour and does not have a REAL ID and we don't want that to happen to you!
